1. There is **no victory** on our own
Revelation 5:1-4

And I saw in the right hand of Him who sat on the throne a scroll written inside and on the back, sealed with seven seals. ² Then I saw a strong angel proclaiming with a loud voice, "Who is worthy to open the scroll and to loose its seals?" ³ And no one in heaven or on the earth or under the earth was able to open the scroll, or to look at it. ⁴ So I wept much, because no one was found worthy to open and read the scroll, or to look at it.

1. There is **no victory** on our own

- John the disciple was worshipping God when he received a series of visions that became the book of Revelation...

1. There is **no victory** on our own

Revelation 5:1-4

John is caught up to see

- The throne room of heaven and invited into a splendid scene of worship
- God holding a scroll

John heard

- An angel proclaiming "Who is worthy to open the scroll and to loose its seals?"

1. There is **no victory** on our own

Revelation 5:1-4

John realized:

- No one in God's creation is able *to open the scroll and to loose its seals?*"

John reacted:

- He is crushed, and wept

There is **victory** through the Lamb

Revelation 5:5-7

But one of the elders said to me, “Do not weep. Behold, the Lion of the tribe of Judah, the Root of David, has prevailed to open the scroll and to loose its seven seals.”⁶ And I looked, and behold, in the midst of the throne and of the four living creatures, and in the midst of the elders, stood a Lamb as though it had been slain, having seven horns and seven eyes, which are the seven Spirits of God sent out into all the earth.⁷ Then He came and took the scroll out of the right hand of Him who sat on the throne.

2. There is **victory** through the Lamb Revelation 5:5-7

John heard:

- Stop crying, because there is a solution

“Do not weep. Behold, the Lion of the tribe of Judah, the Root of David, has prevailed to open the scroll and to loose its seven seals.”

2. There is **victory** through the Lamb Revelation 5:5-7

John looked and saw

- A Lamb, standing as if slain, who comes and takes the scroll

- The image(s) of Jesus Christ

 - *Genesis 49:8-10 ...From the line of Judah

 - *Isaiah 11:1 ... the Root of David

2. There is **victory** through the Lamb Revelation 5:5-7

Jesus Christ was worthy to open the scroll not because of His might, but because of the cross.

The “Lion” has become the slain **“Lamb”**

- John 1:29 *“The next day John saw Jesus coming toward him, and said, “Behold! The Lamb of God who takes away the sin of the world!” (NKJV)*

Jesus Christ conquers sin by dying, like a lamb, and delivering His people through His blood

- Revelation 5:11-12
- Isaiah 53:7

Jesus Christ accomplishes
God's saving plan

Jesus Christ gains victory
over our enemy – sin – by
dying for our sin as our
sacrifice.

The **victorious** Jesus is worthy of worship

Revelation 5:8-14

Now when He had taken the scroll, the four living creatures and the twenty-four elders fell down before the Lamb, each having a harp, and golden bowls full of incense, which are the prayers of the saints. ⁹ And they sang a new song, saying: "You are worthy to take the scroll, And to open its seals; For You were slain, And have redeemed us to God by Your blood Out of every tribe and tongue and people and nation, ¹⁰ And have made us kings and priests to our God; And we shall reign on the earth."

The **victorious** Jesus is worthy of worship

Revelation 5:8-14

¹¹ Then I looked, and I heard the voice of many angels around the throne, the living creatures, and the elders; and the number of them was ten thousand times ten thousand, and thousands of thousands, ¹² saying with a loud voice: "Worthy is the Lamb who was slain To receive power and riches and wisdom, And strength and honor and glory and blessing!" ¹³ And every creature which is in heaven and on the earth and under the earth and such as are in the sea, and all that are in them, I heard saying: "Blessing and honor and glory and power Be to Him who sits on the throne, And to the Lamb, forever and ever!" ¹⁴ Then the four living creatures said, "Amen!" And the twenty-four elders fell down and worshiped Him who lives forever and ever.
