The Wholeness of Worship Isaiah 6:1-8 (NKJV)

1. **From the sermon** [give a brief answer]

Here, amid the crisis of King Uzziah's death, Isaiah learns something about the impact of worship and holiness on our hearts.

Four things we can learn from experiences of Isaiah:

a) How was Isaiah's feel when he experience a vision of God's throne? (6:5)

When Isaiah recognized of what of his sinfulness, what did God do? (6:6-7)

b) Holiness is activated by worship (6:3)

How can we be holy?

c) Wholeness is restored by worship

But God calls us to worship in His presence in order that a transfer of His being into us may take place. Then the worth that has been worn off the coin of our lives—His nature within us—begins to be restored through worship. Worship is the situation in which wholeness is restored. Because of God's worth poured into us, we become worthy.

d) Mission is found in worship (6:8)
