vv.24-26

"being justified freely by His grace through the redemption that is in Christ Jesus, ²⁵ whom God set forth as a propitiation by His blood, through faith, to demonstrate His righteousness, because in His forbearance God had passed over the sins that were previously committed, ²⁶ to demonstrate at the present time His righteousness, that He might be just and the justifier of the one who has faith in lesus."



- Atonement is at-one-ment
- The blood of Jesus makes us at-one with God.

 a) Sin needs to be wiped away; guilt removed.
 "...expiation" (1 John 1:7)

 b) God's anger against sin must be appeased.
 "...propitiation" (Romans 3:25)

God has given the results of His salvation

- It results in Unity (vs. 29-30)
- It results in Continuity (vs. 31)
