Kingdom People

1. The Kingdom includes people who need a physician
2. The Kingdom includes people who enjoy the Lord's presence

1. – The Kingdom includes people who need a physician

- Mark 2:14-17

*He saw Levi the son of Alphaeus sitting at the tax office, and He said to him, “Follow Me!” So he got up and followed Him.... “Those who are well don’t **need a doctor**, but the sick do need one. I didn’t come to call the righteous, but sinners.”*

The Kingdom includes people who need a physician

Mark 2:14-17

2. The Kingdom includes people who enjoy the Lord's presence

- Mark 2:18-22

...Your disciples do not fast?" ...As long as they have the groom with them, they cannot fast... And no one puts new wine into old wineskins. Otherwise, the wine will burst the skins, and the wine is lost as well as the skins

2. The Kingdom includes people who enjoy the Lord's presence

- Mark 2:18-22
 - a) A complaint about fasting (2:18-20)
 - b) Jesus' reason for rejoicing

3. The Kingdom includes people who surrender to the Lord

- Mark 2:23-28

On the Sabbath .., “Look, why are they doing what is not lawful on the Sabbath?” ...Then He told them, “The Sabbath was made for^[k] man and not man for^[l] the Sabbath. ²⁸ Therefore, the Son of Man is Lord even of the Sabbath.”

- b) Jesus is The Lord of the Sabbath (2:25-28)
