What Jesus saw

... "he saw the crowds" [the multitudes] an opportunity for witness and ministry.

- He saw their needs
- He saw their lost condition
- He saw their potential

What Jesus felt

• "he had compassion on them" Moved with compassion ...means He literally became sick inside ...Jesus was heartsick, burdened, and brokenhearted over His lost city and nation ... how about us!!

What Jesus said

Then he said to his disciples, "The harvest is plentiful but the workers are few. 38 Ask the Lord of the harvest, therefore, to send out workers into his harvest field." (9:37-38)

What Jesus said

- Jesus said three things:
- 1. "The harvest . . . is plentiful" (v. 37)
- 2. "The workers are few" (v. 37)
- 3. "Ask the Lord of the harvest, therefore, to send out workers into his harvest field" (v. 38)

These twelve Jesus sent out and commanded them, saying: "Do not go into the way of the Gentiles, and do not enter a city of the Samaritans. (Matthew 10:5)
