"I will make you into a great nation, and I will bless you; I will make your name great, and you will be a blessing. (v 2)

3. God's sending of His people to bless the nations is the very essence of the gospel.

Scripture foresaw that God would justify the Gentiles by faith, and announced the gospel in advance to Abraham: "All nations will be blessed through you." So those who rely on faith are blessed along with Abraham, the man of faith. (Ga-la-ti 3: 8)

the good news had already been proclaimed to Abraham in Ur of the Chaldees. God desires to bless His people so that we, in turn, will be a blessing to the nations.
